Being Alert

When we become Christians, we are born into light so we must live in the light - 1 Thess 5:5-11 - 5 You are all sons of the light and sons of the day. WE DO NOT BELONG TO THE NIGHT OR TO THE DARKNESS. 6 So then, let us NOT BE like others, who are asleep, but let us BE alert and self-controlled. 7 For those who sleep, sleep at night, and those who get drunk, get drunk at night. 8 But since we belong to the day, let us be self-controlled, putting on faith and love as a breastplate, and the hope of salvation as a helmet. 9 For God did not appoint us to suffer wrath but to receive salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ. 10 He died for us so that, whether we are awake or asleep, we may live together with him. 11 Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing.

A major part of God's protection for us is us being alert -

Phil 3:2-3- 2 <u>Watch out</u> for those <u>dogs</u>, those <u>men who do evil</u>, those <u>mutilators of the flesh</u>. 3 For it is we who are the circumcision, <u>we who worship by the Spirit of God</u>, who glory in Christ Jesus, and <u>who put **no confidence** in the flesh</u>— Acts 20:29-31 - 29 I know that after I leave, <u>savage wolves will come in among you</u> and <u>will not spare the flock</u>. 30 Even <u>from your own number</u> men will arise and <u>distort the truth</u> in order to draw away disciples after them. 31 <u>So be on your guard!</u> Remember that for three years I never stopped warning each of you night and day with tears.

Alertness is a major part of our defense against the enemy - 1 Peter 5:8-9 - 8 <u>BE self-controlled</u> and <u>alert</u>. Your <u>enemy the devil</u> prowls around like a roaring lion looking for <u>someone to devour</u>. 9 <u>Resist him, standing FIRM in the faith</u>, because you know that your brothers throughout the world are undergoing the same kind of sufferings.

We need to watch how we are with one another or we will be a danger to one another - Gal 5:14-15 - 14 The entire law is summed up in a single command: "Love your neighbor as yourself." 15 If you keep on biting and devouring each other, watch out or you will be destroyed by each other.

If we are not alert the biggest enemy to us is us - Mark 14:38 <u>Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation</u>. The <u>spirit is willing, but the body is weak."</u>

Checking ourselves to make sure we are not the problem - Luke 11:34-36-34 Your eye is the lamp of your body. When your eyes are good, your whole body also is full of light. But when they are bad, your body also is full of darkness. 35 SEE TO IT, then, that the light within you IS NOT DARKNESS. 36 Therefore, if your whole body is full of light, and no part of it dark, it will be completely lighted, as when the light of a lamp shines on you."

Effective alertness in light is making sure <u>how you live</u> and the <u>Word you live by</u> is SOUND- 1 Tim 4:16 <u>Watch your life and</u> doctrine closely. Persevere in them, because **IF YOU DO, you will save** both yourself and your hearers.

HOW CHRISTIAN ALERTNESS IS APPLIED

- We must be <u>SPIRITUALLY</u> ALERT Eph 6:12 For <u>our struggle is not against flesh and blood</u>, but against the <u>rulers</u>, against the <u>authorities</u>, against the <u>powers of this dark world</u> and against the <u>spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms</u>.
- We must also be alert of False teachers and groups Rom 16:17-18 17 <u>I urge you</u>, brothers, to <u>watch out for those</u> who <u>cause divisions</u> and <u>put obstacles in your way THAT ARE CONTRARY to the teaching you have learned</u>. Keep away from them. 18 For <u>such people</u> are not serving our Lord Christ, but their own appetites. By smooth talk and flattery they <u>deceive the minds of naive people</u>.
- Alert of Greed Luke 12:15 Then he said to them, "<u>Watch out!</u> <u>Be on your guard</u> against ALL KINDS OF GREED; a man's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions."
- Alert that we stay on the right path NO MATTER WHAT Gal 6:9 Let us <u>not become weary in doing good</u>, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest <u>if we do not give up.</u>
- Alert that we don't allow "self" to get in the way James 1:13-15 13 When tempted, no one should say, "God is tempting me." For God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does he tempt anyone; 14 but <u>each one is tempted when, by HIS OWN EVIL DESIRE</u>, he is dragged away and enticed. 15 Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death.
- Alert of HOW we live Eph 5:15-18 15 <u>Be very careful</u>, then, HOW YOU LIVE <u>not as unwise but as wise</u>, 16 making the <u>most of every opportunity</u>, <u>because the days are evil</u>. 17 Therefore <u>do not be foolish</u>, but <u>understand what the Lord's will is</u>.
- Most importantly, Alert to see what our life purpose truly is Gal 6:7-8 7 <u>Do not be deceived</u>: <u>God cannot be mocked</u>. A <u>man reaps what he sows</u>. 8 The one who <u>SOWS TO PLEASE HIS SINFUL NATURE</u>, from that nature <u>will reap destruction</u>; the one who <u>SOWS TO PLEASE THE SPIRIT</u>, from the Spirit <u>will reap eternal life</u>.
